The Past Tense of Salvation (Justification) I HAVE BEEN SAVED FROM THE PENALTY OF SIN

*For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, **Ephesians 2:8 ESV***

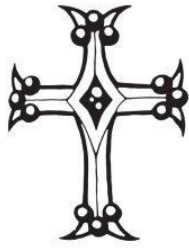
The Present Tense of Salvation (Sanctification) I AM BEING SAVED FROM THE POWER OF SIN

*For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing, **2 Corinthians 2:15 ESV***

The Future Tense of Salvation (Glorification) I WILL BE SAVED FROM THE PRESENCE OF SIN

Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

*For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. **Romans 5:9-10 ESV***
